These classes will take place at the Rectory by appointment only. To register for a Pre-Jordan Class, please call the Rectory during regular business Hours (Monday through Friday, 9am to 4pm). Baptisms may be held on any Sunday once the Pre-Jordan Class is completed.

**Sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation:** Anyone asked to be a Godparent/Sponsor should contact the Rectory regarding their Letter of Eligibility.


**Matrimony:** Couples must contact the priest at least six months prior to the intended wedding date. All couples are required to attend pre-marital instructions in preparation for marriage.

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Who of us doesn't like receiving in the mail an envelope that contains an invitation with an R.S.V.P.? While we like receiving invitations, do we ever stop to think that every day we receive an invitation from Jesus? An invitation to come, to follow Him? And then there's always the question, "How do we respond?"

The readings today give us something to think about regarding our response to that invitation. Some details, we find, are easier to accept than others, yet every invitation from Jesus offers ways for us to grow in faith.

In our reading from Acts, we hear how Stephen responded to the invitation with his whole heart. However, his response to follow Jesus isn't necessarily easy. Stephen is rejected and stoned to death. Yet, his last words as he lay dying were, "Lord do not hold this sin against them." Stephen clearly understood and accepted Jesus' message about the importance of forgiveness. In our second reading, John describes how he hears the voice of the Risen Lord inviting us to remember our baptismal promises. In accepting this invitation to "Come," we will not thirst, we "will receive the gift of life-giving water." Who of us would want to reject such an invitation? In the Gospel, Jesus not only invites us, He prays for us to be as one people, just as He and the Father are one. Jesus prays that the love the Father has for Him may be in us, His disciples, just as He is. Christ is extending an invitation to us to share in His life! Jesus' ultimate concern is the unity of the community of disciples. He wants us to share the love that He and the Father share. Jesus' relationship with the Father is a mutual relationship of giving and receiving love. The unity for which Jesus prayed has already begun in us. This unity is the result of perfect and ongoing self-sacrificing love and sharing. Jesus wants us, His disciples, to be one, just as He and the Father are one. We who believe in Jesus are called to be one by mirroring Jesus. Jesus challenges us to love one another just as He loves us. He wants to share His glory with us. Are we ready to accept the challenge and love as Jesus' loves, and are we willing to share in His glory? Are we willing to mirror Jesus? Are we going to accept the invitations that Jesus offers us daily, so that we may grow in faith?

This weekend is Memorial Day Weekend. Memorial Day itself was a day set aside as a solemn day of mourning and remembrance to honor those who paid the ultimate price for our freedom. Therefore, we remember and honor all who have served our country.

Be assured of my prayers. I ask you to remember me in your prayers.

**CAMP OVERBROOK: IN SIGN 2022**

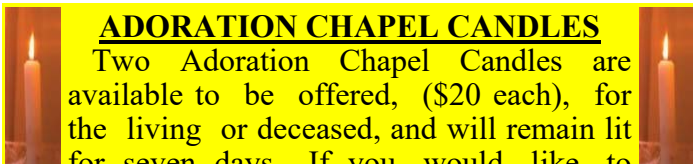
