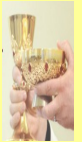

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Each year, parishes in the Archdiocese participate in what is called the Missionary Cooperation Plan. Next weekend, our parish will welcome Father Raju B. Pilla, a missionary representative, who will speak to us on behalf of the Latin Archdiocese of Trivandrum

Trivandrum has about 270,000 Catholics. 90% of the people belong to a fishing community, the majority of whom depend on fishing for their livelihood. 10% are farm workers who are recent converts from the low-class Hindus. Unemployment and poverty are most rampant in the communities. The Archdiocese depends on outside contributions to support its clergy, seminarians, catechists, and the humanitarian projects of the homes for orphans, aged and destitute, which provide food, shelter, health care, and education. After being devastated by Cyclone "Tauktae" in 2021, hundreds of families were left homeless. The Archdiocese has yet to recover from the crippling effects of the financial devastation caused by the cyclone and the pandemic lockdowns. With our support, the Archdiocese of Trivandrum, will be able to continue their recovery efforts as well as their missionary work. The second collection will take place on the weekend July 28-29, for this appeal. Thank you, thank you, thank you, for your generosity.

In today's Gospel, the parable of the sower and the seed directs us to ponder the Word of God. God's Word is sown everywhere. Some hear it. Some get it. Some act on it. Some may pay no attention at all to the Word of God, but God gives it anyway. God is a very generous God, something we often hear said but perhaps do not comprehend. Jesus is calling us to look like God and act like God. We would prefer, however, only to passively hear God's word. We resist acting on it. Jesus is teaching us about our mixed response to God's Word. This parable not only directs us to ponder the Word of God, but it also forces us to reflect on how we respond to God's Word. How do we measure up? Are we someone who has heard the message but doesn't care? Has our initial enthusiasm for our faith failed? Did some thorns in our lives drive us away? There are many people who are difficult to deal with even in a Christian community; are the weeds choking us? Perhaps we are at times the weeds ourselves, teaching our children and others that Church isn't important.

Living and acting on God's Word is not easy, St. Paul acknowledged that acting on God's Word can be difficult and, at first glance, be thought of as a burden. If we live a good moral Christian life, we are likely to be ridiculed. We do not suffer physical persecution, but we do suffer the slings and arrows of a culture that does not hold our values. Paul says to us that following God's Word, while at times can be difficult, is worth it. How then can we be open to the word of God? 1). Practice divine expectation. This means that we not only welcome the words but also welcome an encounter with God. We trust that God's word comes with a particular mission: consolation, peace, strength, and a call to conversion, etc. 2). Practice holy openness. We prepare for reading Scripture by saying with our whole being, "I welcome the change to which God will invite me." 3). Practice holy reading. *Lectio Divina* is a popular practice of prayerfully reading the word of God, trusting the power of the Holy Spirit to reveal insights and call us each to action. 4). Practice gratitude for the way that we encounter God's power in God's word.

Our challenge is to examine our relationship to the Word and message of Jesus Christ. We've heard it; have we listened to it? Are we in the boat or outside of it looking in?

Be assured of my prayers. I ask you to please remember me in your prayers.
