# rom the Pastor's Desk

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

WOW! Time goes by quickly. Here we are at Labor Day weekend. I can't believe that the summer is unofficially over. We welcome back our family members of Stella Maris who have been away for the summer. We also hope that all of you had a nice and relaxing summer and were able to get away for some fun in the sun.

It's the most wonderful time of the year as we hear the school bells ringing! We pray for all of our young parishioners as they begin school. We support and encourage them. We hope and pray they will have a good learning experience.

Today's reading could be summed up in one word, HUMILITY. Authentic humility does not necessarily involve humiliation; rather it comes from acknowledging what is true. God is God, and we are not. God is all-powerful and we are not. But that also means, as the Psalm reminds us, that God can and will do for us what is beyond our own reach, if only we will allow it. Jesus made similar points with His parable of the wedding feast in today's Gospel from St. Luke. When we are guests, we do well not to presume our own importance and sit in the place of honor without being asked. We risk embarrassment if the host has to come and ask us to move to a lower place. But taking the lowest place voluntarily just might result in a flattering invitation to move up higher. If we are honest, none of us could ever deserve, by our own merits, to be seated at the Lord's table at all. And yet, He invites and includes us all. The realization of God's generosity to us should, in turn, opens our own hearts. Jesus would have us in memory of Him, emulate God's hospitality by including "the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind" at our own tables.

Human opinion never determined Jesus' actions and it should not determine ours. His Father's opinion was all that mattered. Therefore, it is through humility that we find favor with God. True humility is having a modest opinion of one's own importance, allows us to give recognition to others without jealousy, and helps us rejoice in the success of others without being envious. Humble acts cannot be done to achieve any purpose other than to please God, who exhibited the greatest act of humility in becoming human.

Therefore, humility is having an accurate knowledge of ourselves and acceptance of ourselves. It enables us to use our unique gifts while giving the glory to God. We must be willing to rely on God if we want to be close to God and the kingdom.

Be assured of my prayers. I ask you to remember me in your prayers

- 2) Signed copy of "Appendix B" from the CCD Handbook
- 3) Signed letter of permission from your pastor (only if you are not a member of Stella Maris Parish)
- 4) Baptismal certificate for all **new** registrations (only if your child was **not baptized** at Stella Maris)

Please note: CCD classes are held on Sunday mornings.
